Dear Mr. Widen:

Thank you for your letter dated June 19th, 2008.

The board of Directors of CRTV has unanimously recommended that our members accept the offer by Shaw Cablesystems Limited to purchase the assets of CRTV pending both CRTV Members approval and CRTC approval. This information was sent to all CRTV members during the past week.

The decision on the future of CRTV is up to all our members to make. In turn, a special proxy was sent to all CRTV members on June 18th, 2008.

As you are fully aware, CRTV is presently competing with Star Choice, Bell ExpressVu, and Telus, for TV services and high speed internet. CRTV customers are demanding bundled services that include regular telephone, cellular phone, Pay Per View, Special Events and Video On Demand, but to date, CRTV has not been able to offer these services.

The fact of the matter is that CRTV is losing customers to the competition in all areas and that at this point CRTV is in its best position to sell. It is our belief that the value of CRTV will quickly decrease should Shaw begin to directly compete with us. In a competition between a company with three million subscribers and one with 12,500 members, the eventual outcome is quite evident. CRTV has received a reasonable and fair offer from Shaw, the Board has recommended that the offer be accepted, the decision as to CRTV's future is now in the hands of all of its members, and the results of this decision will be known in early July.
